

"I grew up in a house packed to the brim, surrounded by destructive friends, habits, and lifestyles... with very little knowledge of this man that died on the cross for us."

"My life before The Bridge was not


always easy. I grew up with drugs and alcohol and abuse all around me.

The first time I went to The Bridge I felt safe. There were no drugs, no alcohol, no violence. There was food and just an overall safe place that I couldn't wait to go back to.

The leaders would open their arms and give us the biggest hugs. They would actually listen to us and not just pretend to listen. They would make sure to make you feel special.

Life since The Bridge has been not always an easy path, but I know I wouldn't be who I am today if I never stepped foot in those doors.

The Bridge opened up so many positive opportunities for me and helped me believe there are good things out there, even when I felt

sometimes 'this was it, this was life.'
Going to camp at Gem Lake, canoe

## How you can support our staff and keep us together in Christ

You know it as well as we do: the North End is full of young leaders with passion and promise ready to serve their community and grow their skills. This is why we hire them as staff!

But not too long ago, we saw a big problem: these staff often didn't have the networks behind them to raise enough salary support for themselves.



So on top of focussing on their jobs, they had to worry about raising enough for a living wage. It just wasn't working.

Instead, you helped us introduce something that really did work: The Unity Fund. A way to ensure all staff were equally supported, regardless of their background. Instead of asking staff to find their own supporters, we pooled support and split it among staff.

#### "Without the Unity Fund I wouldn't be able to do this kind of work."

But what does a model like that actually do? We'll let staff member Jenelle explain it.

"I would not be able to work here at ICYA if the Unity Fund did not exist. I don't have people around me who would be able to support me in that way.

The Unity Fund allows me to have the opportunity to work in this environment with kids in the community. I get to teach kids and teens about who God is and plant seeds in each of their lives. I love that I get to walk alongside these youth and mentor them.
